| 1 Lb. Round Steak | 1 cup Sour Cream |
| 2/3 Cup Water | 1 Tbsp. Flour |
| 4 Ounce Can Sliced Mushrooms | 1 Bag Egg Noodles, Buttered |

Cut meat in small pieces. Heat fat in skillet, (3 Tbsp. total). Brown meat in fat quickly. Add water and mushrooms, stir in soup mix and heat till boiling. Blend in sour cream and flour; add to mixture. Cook and stir until mixture thickens. Serve over hot noodles.
